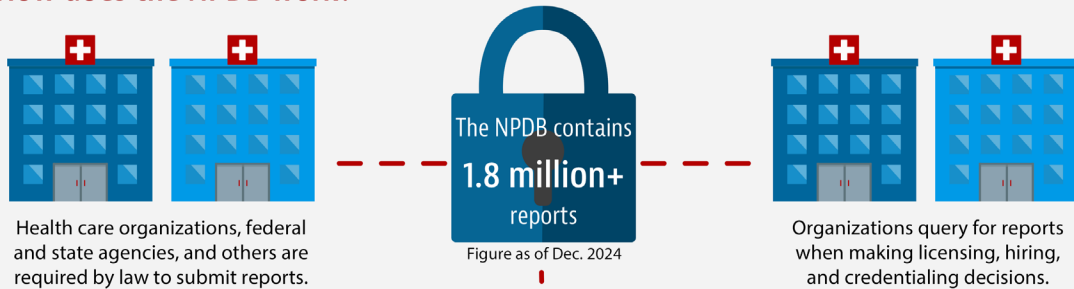


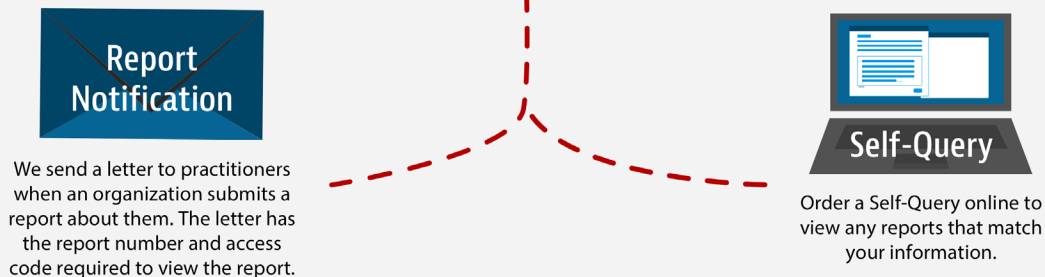
A PRACTITIONER'S GUIDE TO THE NPDB
